As I reflect on my first year

as Director of Admissions, one of the most enjoyable aspects of my job is sharing with families how Holy Child has benefited my own children. With both Tommy '15 and Grace '16 as graduates, and Claudia now a 7th grader, I often talk about their journeys through our School. They all began here as 3-year-olds and have had the benefit of experiencing all three divisions of our School.

While many new families have children who will enroll in our Early Childhood division, I realized early in my new role that it is important for parents to hear and learn about all three divisions of our School. It is the intellectual, emotional, and social growth our students achieve as they progress through our divisions that I appreciate so much as a parent at Holy Child. The importance of our Middle School in that progression is a message that I believe parents need to hear.

Our Middle School has so many amazing aspects. It almost goes without saying that our academics are outstanding. The evidence is the immediate success of our graduates, who go to the high schools of their choice with nearly 100% of their applications accepted. They attend some of the best high schools in the region, and beyond.



They enter high school well prepared, with most of our graduates placing in honors classes. Holy Child graduates go on to be leaders at their high schools, taking with them so much more than just academic preparedness.

It is important for parents to remember that our Middle School is our upper school. The fact that we don't have a high school is a great advantage and opportunity for our students. It was a brilliant June day when Anne Marie Crinnion '12 looked out on a huge throng from the podium at the Academy of Notre Dame de Namur in Villanova, the kind of day that God envisioned when he created spring.

For Anne Marie, being chosen as Valedictorian at the select Main Line school affirmed the quality of her educational journey – “a reward greater than no other to know that people around you that have worked so hard think you have something meaningful to say.”

And it was a shared experience with a good friend, Rachel Weber '12, who welcomed that assembly as Notre Dame’s Salutatorian – a unique moment when two students from the same school, Holy Child School at Rosemont, were the featured student speakers at a prominent high school’s graduation exercise.

“It was so special to have Anne Marie and I together,” Rachel said. “We’ve grown up together, and I thought about how much we’ve accomplished to get this far.”

And ultimately, she said, it was a reflection of having emerged from “such a wonderful community at Holy Child, a connection that doesn’t ever fade away. It turns you into a person that others recognize. It is an amazing feeling.”

“Holy Child helped develop the confidence that enabled me to do the things I did at Notre Dame,” said Anne Marie. “You develop a feeling of responsibility at such a young age and develop the ability to impact those around you. The main thing was that 8th graders were the oldest students in the school, compared to where I am now; other students looked up to us and that gave you great confidence.”

Anne Marie and Rachel are among many recent graduates of Holy Child who have risen to positions of prominence in Main Line-area high schools. They are, as Head of School Tom Lengel P’12 says, “shining examples of our Middle School program.” ❖

Our Commencement Mass is a joyous ceremony that signifies a rite of passage for our graduates. Their achievements are recognized and celebrated. They stand at the altar as young adults, brimming with confidence and anticipation of future success, well equipped to address the challenges at their next educational institution. In a typical year, nearly all of their applications to area independent schools are accepted.

“Our students benefit from a robust, multi-faceted experience at Holy Child, guided by caring teachers who are educational experts in their fields,” said Deb Borden, Associate Head of School and Director of Middle School. “Our small class sizes and small-group instruction models in our student-centered classrooms promote their collaboration and leadership qualities. The students hone their critical thinking skills to not only acquire essential information through independent work, but also strategies to profess their knowledge to classmates and their teachers.”

As always, said Mrs. Borden, the additional components of

extracurricular activities, electives, religious instruction, and community service are essential to enhancing the experience at Holy Child. Their extracurricular experience is promoted by Holy Child’s no-cut policy, unique among middle schools in the region,

which enables students of all skill levels to take risks and expand their horizons.

“For example, our Middle School has varsity and junior varsity teams, the same as upper schools at other institutions; this adds emphasis to the teams,” she said. “The students take great pride in developing organizational systems. Middle School is more than a time to gain knowledge; it also is a time to attain character, and that is exemplified by the number of students who achieve prominent positions in high school.

“We set the bar pretty high at Holy Child,” Mrs. Borden concluded with a smile. “We repeatedly are told by area high schools how desirable our applicants are to them, and we are confident that they will enjoy an easy transition based on the foundation that has been provided for them at Holy Child.” ❖

MICHAEL EICHERT: Young Man in Motion

Michael Eichert '08 is a living testimonial to the parable that if you want something done, ask a busy person. Since graduating from Holy Child School at Rosemont, he has been a young man in motion.

At The Episcopal Academy, Michael pursued lifelong extracurricular passions with the arts - he was a Cappy Award winner - and technology. He even launched an online, multimedia student arts publication, and then created others for The Agnes Irwin School and Malvern Preparatory School through a company he co-founded, Intrepage Inc.

Michael had a dual major at New York University in the Stern School of Business in finance and management, and a minor in media entertainment and technology for the Tisch School of Arts - a dual major with graduation ceremonies at the iconic Yankee Stadium (for NYU) and Madison Square Garden (for Stern). New York's not the Big Apple for nothing!

Along the way he co-chaired The Met College Group to promote the Metropolitan Museum of Art, and engaged in a number of internships, most prominently in digital advertising with NBCUniversal. Small wonder he was presented the Award for

Academic Excellence in Management from the Stern School of Business.

Michael looks back on his education at Holy Child as foundational for his career.

“Holy Child provided me with a very open, comfortable and free environment to experiment and just try new things,” he said, “anything I wanted. It set me up for what I did in high school in terms of acting and entrepreneurial things.

“The School gave me license to be creative without worrying about being judged or messing up. It was a very supportive environment. I felt if I could do what made me happy and productive and benefited the larger community in some way, I should try it - whether it be the arts, MATHCOUNTS, the yearbook or Robotics or whatever.”

After graduation, Michael has been employed at the prominent Philadelphia business management consultant Ernst & Young as a management consultant in media and entertainment. Clearly, he has flourished at being a risk-taker.

“That’s something Holy Child forged in me,” he said, “and something that I’ll take with me forever.” ❖

MATT NUTTALL P'27

Matt Nuttall joined the Holy Child School at Rosemont faculty in August 2014 as a 7th grade English and history teacher. He began his teaching career after graduating with a Bachelor of Arts degree in economics from College of the Holy Cross before moving east in the summer of 2014. He and his wife, Robin, have one son, Oliver '27.

Why did you come to Holy Child?

The practical answer is that it was time for us to move. My wife is from here, and we spent a bit of time looking in the area. What immediately appealed to me was the opportunity to teach both subjects.

What was your first impression of the School?

That the students were equal parts very young and very mature. It's something the School does well. One moment the students can be full of fun and enthusiasm, and the next minute they can lead a visiting parent on a tour, explaining our product in a way we'd expect of adults.

What would you tell prospective parents about Holy Child?

That these are really well-cared-for students who also are really intellectually challenged and curious, which tells us we're doing something right.

How would you evaluate the curriculum compared to other schools where you've worked?

Although I've modified my curriculum from what I taught my high school students, in all truth I have modified it very little. I've told my students they are doing 9th grade work; they might not have the same depth or breadth as 9th graders, but it is awfully similar. I've had many students during my two years here that absolutely rival the 9th graders I had previously, and that was a college prep school, too.

You employed new, standing work stations last year. Why?

To me the physical space is a big part of learning; it's not just a classroom but a home base, where they have ownership. It really pays off for a student who maybe doesn't choose to change his place of ownership and knows that one day he can.

What is the best part about teaching?

The kids, every day of the week and twice on Sundays.

Class of 2016: A Path Well Traveled, a Journey Completed

The final graduating class under the name of Rosemont School of the Holy Child also was one of the School's most celebrated.

During the 61st Commencement Mass, which was held at St. Thomas of Villanova Church on June 2, eleven members of the 32-student Class of 2016 were recognized for being awarded a total of 19 scholarships to area independent schools.

This class, said Co-President Jude Minnich, was a collection of students who were willing to push themselves to take risks and reap the benefits that resulted.

"We have had a great journey to get to this moment, and we have an exciting journey ahead," said Jude in his opening Reflection. "During our time at Rosemont School, mistakes were made and hard lessons were learned. What we will remember are our successes, our friendships, the respect and love that we share for our School, our friends, our teachers and coaches, and all of the valuable lessons that the entire staff at Rosemont School has taught us."

Co-President Abby Butler, in her Reflection, told the congregation of faculty, staff, classmates, family, and friends that what she most remembers about her 10 years at Rosemont School are "the relationships that we have created here."

"We have faced many challenges, socially, academically, athletically, and inside of ourselves. Yet it amazes me how strong we still are, and how strong our bonds still are. We are truly a family, and one that will never be forgotten.

Abby acknowledged the instrumental guides on the students' journey: the parents "who supported us through these many years," and the Rosemont School teachers.

"It takes special people who can talk and then light a fire in us all to achieve the best work we can," she said, "and the teachers here at Rosemont School really have done that ... they have all guided us on good paths."

Future students will graduate from Holy Child School at Rosemont, which became our new School name in January. The decision to change the name was made by the Board of Trustees in order to underscore the qualities of Holy Child's educational program that is built around the progressive educational philosophy of Society of the Holy Child Jesus Foundress Cornelia Connelly. ❖

The Lowe & Edmonds Family: WHY WE ARE A HOLY CHILD FAMILY



Kim Lowe P’16 and daughter Kyla Edmonds ’16—who now attends Merion Mercy Academy—became members of the Holy Child School at Rosemont community in 2008. Kim sat down recently for an interview to talk about their experience.

What brought you to Holy Child?

A granddaughter of a parishioner at St. Martin de Porres read a poem at his funeral, and I was moved by her confidence and poise. I knew that the school she attended was a good school. I learned she was a 6th grader at Holy Child when I spoke to her parents afterward. I was looking for another option for my daughter, to get her out of the neighborhood. Cost was an issue, but it was the best risk I ever took.

Tell us about your inner-city neighborhood.

Last weekend someone was murdered across the street from our home. A lot of people don’t know that Kyla had to deal with three murders in her community last year. Fortunately, the environment at Holy Child gave her other things to talk about rather than the ills of society. She began buying into optimism. She got to learn about this community, and the people here got to know us, too. It worked both ways. We found we had much more in common than differences.

How has she benefited in other ways?

Kyla has learned to be resilient, to acclimate to different environments; she got a different perspective on people, relationships, teamwork, and the realities of society. The beauty of the Holy Child community is that the families don’t always

have to be great to be appreciated. It was hard to leave this very safe environment, but we’re very excited because we know that Holy Child prepared us for that.

What did Kyla most enjoy about Holy Child?

One of the biggest complaints from the kids in her neighborhood is the lack of resources. Holy Child allowed her to utilize the technology of today and have all the tools she needed to succeed. And she also liked the inclusiveness in games and activities.

Do you feel that Kyla is well prepared for high school?

The placement tests say a lot; the numbers don’t lie. Even though she struggled in certain subjects, compared nationally to other schools, she is where she needs to be, which is above average. You want children to succeed in life, not just school, and those skills come with a quality education like she got at Holy Child.

What would you tell a prospective parent about Holy Child?

If you want a school that truly wants to know your child and embrace your family, Holy Child is it. We’re truly all part of a team, and we have to be on the same page. And the school takes a holistic approach, knowing what goes on at home, which really helps. If you have an open mind, come and visit the School and see what I mean by “spirit.” There are a lot of great buildings, but the spirit of Holy Child permeates through the people; that is something you can’t sell but you can feel. ❖

KATHARINE CRESKOFF GARVEY '91

PEDIATRIC ENDOCRINOLOGIST



BOSTON, MA

Pediatric endocrinology is both a job and a mission for Katharine (Kate) Creskoff Garvey '91, MD, MPH. She specializes in the treatment of patients with Type 1 juvenile diabetes at Boston Children's Hospital, concurrently conducting research as to its causes and the incidence spike of this life-changing condition.



"It has been increasing, and the reasons are unclear," Kate said from her home in Boston, MA. "It strikes about one in every 300 children in the U.S., and is the second most common pediatric illness after asthma. The vast majority of kids don't have family history, so there definitely are environmental triggers."

Patient care, she said, "is my passion." She also is conducting research to deliver health care using innovative methods, to address the challenges as children transition into adolescence and then adulthood. Treatment is one thing; ideally, prevention will be another. "It's definitely a hot area we are working in," Kate concluded.

It also is an area all-too-familiar for the Garvey family. Luke, the oldest son of Kate and Matt Garvey, was diagnosed with Type 1 juvenile diabetes four years ago at the age of 4.

"It was quite ironic and really has opened my eyes to other aspects of what it's like to deal with diabetes," Kate said. "Luke is doing great with an insulin pump and is a totally healthy kid. But managing diabetes is a lot of work; every time he eats you have to make complex decisions about his blood sugar. It requires a lot

of education. Overall, this specialty is a lot like being a teacher, telling people of different backgrounds and different walks of life how to deal with this. And now I'm doing this as a parent, and you learn how pervasive this can be and how tough it is even for people of my background to deal with it."

Kate has two other children: Isabel, 6, and infant Colin, who was born May 25. She feels that her foundation for her home and career were established at Holy Child School at Rosemont, where she was a "lifer" student.

"I was exposed to such caring teachers, and I selected a career in diabetes because so much of that is working with families to give them the tools to manage the disease," Kate said. "You have to be patient and very caring, because it's very complicated to take care of a child with diabetes. Being exposed to such considerate teachers so early on made me want to do that and made it work for me."

exceptional role models, and were caring and extremely skilled educators. They really had this passion for what they did and for the kids. At an early age they instilled a series of values in each of us and the importance of actions and taking care of other people in the community. They helped shape what I am today."

That education, Kate concluded, is generated "from a warm, supportive community that envelops each child. It incorporates a superb education and value structure on top of the whole package that is really setting each child up for academic success, and helps guide our decisions so we can give back to the community." ❖

For one thing, Holy Child played a monumental impact on her life ... and the performing arts central to her Holy Child experience.

"I came to the School in 1st grade after my parents came to an open house and thought it was a wonderful place for me to be ... and it was," Stephanie said. "And right from the start my parents wanted to be involved in the School.

"Arts were prominent in my family," Stephanie said. "Number one, my mom (Elizabeth) was involved in Gilbert and Sullivan productions in the Philadelphia area before she met dad. When I was growing up, my mom still did the shows, and Dad (Charles) - who was a huge supporter - used to watch me while she went downtown to Philadelphia for rehearsals from our home in Malvern."

So when Stephanie enrolled at Holy Child, she naturally gravitated toward the School productions. As did her parents. Her mother regularly volunteered in the classroom and at the former Country Fair. Her father, who was a Trustee, built booths for the Country Fair and the stages for the Spring Play.

"The play was such a big part of the Holy Child community," Stephanie recalled. "I can't think of the play without thinking of the parents that were involved. They built the sets, sold ads in the programs, brought families to the performances.

"Holy Child has been blessed with so many contributions from the families. That's something my parents felt was really important."

Currently, Stephanie and her husband Steve, a technology executive, and their three sons are enjoying life on the West Coast, but Holy Child is still close to her soul. She traveled cross-country to attend her Holy Child class reunion in 2011, for example. And as a tribute to her parents and their spirit of volunteerism at her School, this year Stephanie has endowed the Charles and Elizabeth Luttrell Middle School Play Fund, to support the operations of the Spring Play.

The idea partially resulted from conversations with her Shipley High School friend, Tammy Kelly P'15'17'21, whose husband Tim

"God is all about love, and acting in a loving way fulfills what God wants us to do. It also helps to fulfill the Holy Child mission."

Expanding Opportunities for a Holy Child Education

A quality independent school education should be an opportunity for the many, not just a privileged few, contends Ted Wahl P'20'23'25. Thanks to a change in Pennsylvania's tax code, Mr. Wahl is helping to make that opportunity more possible than ever.

Pennsylvania's Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) and Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit (OSTC) programs, which were enacted in 2001, originally enabled the business community to direct a significant portion of their state tax obligations to provide tuition assistance at independent schools. (EITC funds benefit income eligible families, while OSTC contributions are dedicated to children from Pennsylvania's lowest-performing schools.)

Legislation passed in 2014 opened these programs to individual investments as well. However, said Mr. Wahl, "most individuals didn't appear to know they were eligible to contribute."

Two years ago he approached Head of School Tom Lengel P'12 and Director of Institutional Advancement Kristen Luke Brooks about promoting the program to the Holy Child community and beyond. Mr. Wahl then began organizing informational meetings about the program at Holy Child, as well as with other individuals.

He and colleagues created the Montgomery Avenue LLC for local independent schools, which provides pro bono accounting and administrative services to donors. "Literally, all an individual has to do is sign the agreement, write the check and when it's time to file taxes, we'll provide the Schedule K-1," Mr. Wahl said. "We're blessed to have such good people to work with, donating hours of personal time, and we all know how valuable that is." *(continued on next page)*

Any person that signs on for two years receives a 90-percent tax credit with the state, as well as approximately a five-percent credit with the federal government. "For a \$5,000 donation, the net out-of-pocket cost is \$250 to the individual," Mr. Wahl said.

Last year Montgomery LLC raised more than \$250,000, more than half of which was directed to Holy Child. "This year we plan to meet or exceed that amount," Mr. Wahl said.

Expanding educational opportunities "has been a passion of mine for a long time," said Mr. Wahl, who recalls lobbying Harrisburg for school vouchers as an 8th grader during a class trip. "But vouchers were not politically acceptable."

"This program allows that opportunity for other children as well. And we are confident that it can change lives."
