NC12, Congresswoman, United States House of Representatives
Congresswoman Alma S. Adams was elected to her third term representing the 12th Congressional District of North Carolina on November 6, 2018. For 40 years, Dr. Adams taught Art at Bennett College in Greensboro, North Carolina. She began her political career in the 1980s, becoming the first African American woman ever elected to the Greensboro City School Board. She served nine years on the Greensboro City Council and ten terms in the North Carolina General Assembly—chairing the North Carolina Legislative Black Caucus.

Mr. Smith has worked to create transformative educational spaces in high schools, a community college, a public state university, and a private college.
